Concern about People

How many worries and hardships has St. Joseph been through for the sake of the people! Let us lend our ears to how he coped with everyday life:

He happily sacrificed himself in a peaceful harmony and full consent with Mary in his concern for the incarnate Redeemer. His work filled him with holy enthusiasm. He turned all his earthly work at the carpenter’s bench, his entire craftsmanship into an extremely holy act. In order to provide a livelihood for the divine Child and His Mother, nothing was too troublesome for him, no privation too great, no disappointment too bitter.

For his little Family he did everything out of pure love and devotion. That is the reason why he was not put off by the great difficulties in the stable of Bethlehem, the extremely great troubles and dangers of the flight into Egypt as well as the great sacrifices and fears for his Family in a foreign country. The devil greatly tormented Joseph and often drove him to great anxiety that his Spouse and the Child would be kidnapped. He could often hardly wait for the evening to come in order to go home and make sure that nothing had happened to them. He undertook everything to somehow make their lives bearable there. Also for Mary it was a matter of course to have a caring eye on Joseph in order to unburden him of sacrifices and, with her kind heart of a mother, to give him relief as discreetly as possible. Apart from the great joy of returning home to Nazareth to the verdurous Galilee, worries were loyal companions, the strain of the long and tiring journey for the Mother and Child, heat, cold, lack of water and food, various great dangers, and so on. Heaven accompanied them. In Nazareth they quietly lived their daily lives and celebrated the holy feasts, and each lived for the other – in joy and sorrow.

Both Mary and Joseph had an open eye and a very open heart for the divine Child, because this Child was, indeed, a constant revelation to them.
