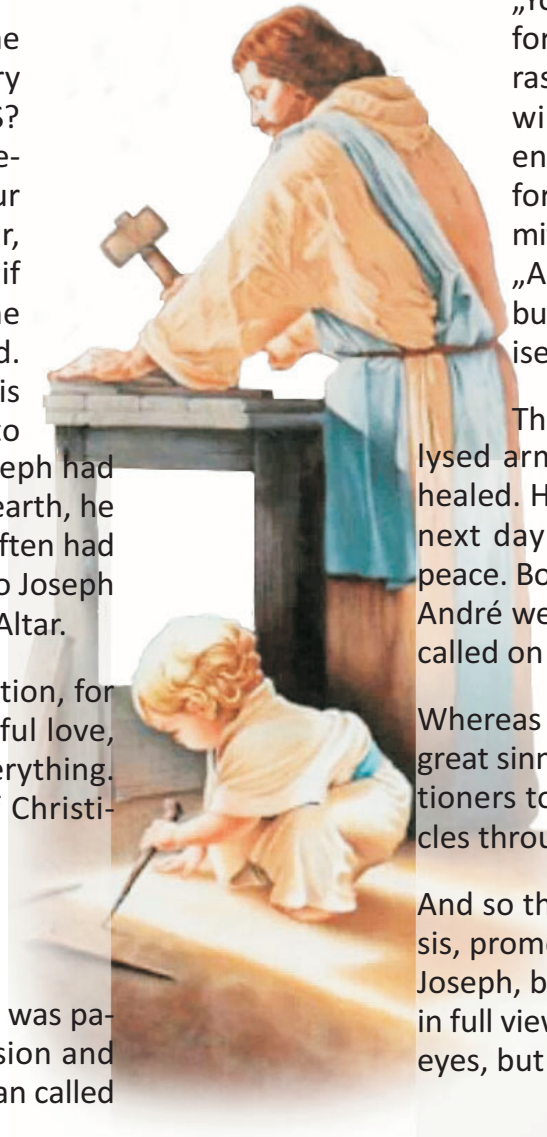
do not go this way, we will get stuck to the poor world. Joseph was tried by many worries and tribulations and in this way constantly perfected his life.

Have our supplies of spiritual goods not been hopelessly cut down? – How often do we struggle in our spiritual dryness to pray – Joseph is a good teacher, teaching us not to slacken in prayer. Go to Joseph, if you are tempted, if you are struggling to stay on the path of virtue, to leave the tempting world behind. Remember that Joseph is always near to you with his unshakeable peace and calmness. He helps you to remain strong in the midst of storms. One day Brother André met a man whose right arm was paralysed. He resolutely ordered him: „Go to confession and then start a novena to St Joseph!“ Astounded the man called



out: „What did you say?“ – „Go to confession, you have not seen a confessional for a long time!“ –

„You are right, father! I have not been to confession for at least 35 years!“ His daughter was very embarrassed and touched his arm: „Be quiet, papa, people will hear what you say!“ – „My child, I was brave enough to remain without receiving the Sacraments for 35 years, so now I should be brave enough to admit it in public!“ – „Quite right!“ agreed Brother André. „And now take your hat, but not with your left hand, but with your right hand. – So, now honour your promise!“

The man was dumbfounded, he could move his paralysed arm freely and made the sign of the cross. He was healed. He immediately went into the confessional and the next day he received Holy Communion, his heart full of peace. Both St John Vianney, parish priest of Ars and Brother André were fervent devotees of the most holy Virgin Mary, called on her regularly and were happy to pray the Rosary.

Whereas John Vianney, the parish priest of Ars, referred the great sinners to Mary, Brother André recommended his petitioners to turn to St Joseph. He worked his countless miracles through the intercession of this great Saint.
