Joseph's Election

Joseph reached the age of 60 years and a few days. He had lived for 27 years by the side of his most pure Spouse. At his death, Mary was in her 42nd year. Mary felt great natural sorrow over Joseph's death for she loved him not only as her spouse, but also as a Saint of excellent perfection and as her benefactor and protector. Her sorrow was well ordered and most perfect, but not any less for that. Her love was the greater because she found him inscribed amongst the highest Saints in the Book of Life and in the Spirit of GOD. ...

With regard to the gifts of grace, I recognised a difference between St Joseph and other Saints. Many Saints received gifts of grace which were not aimed at their own holiness, but had the purpose of moving other people to the service of GOD. They are not directly related to holiness.

In the case of St Joseph, however, all the gifts bestowed upon him included an increase in his virtue and holiness, because his ministry was a matter of holiness and his own activity. The holier, the more angelic he was, the more suitable he was to be the spouse of the most holy Virgin Mary and the Guardian of the mysteries of Heaven. He was to be an utter miracle of holiness, as so he was indeed. This miracle began with him as early as in his mother's womb. Divine Providence endowed him with outstanding qualities and inclinations to virtue. He was sanctified seven months after his conception, and in the process, evil desire was bound for the whole time of his life, so that he never had an impure or disorderly emotion. In this first sanctification he was only cleansed from original sin, he did not yet receive the use of reason. His mother felt an unusual joy of the HOLY SPIRIT at that time, without fully understanding the mystery. She practised great acts of virtue and thought her child would be wonderful in the sight of GOD and men.

Joseph's Birth

At his birth Joseph was very beautiful. He aroused extraordinary joy in his parents and relatives, similar to the birth of John the Baptist. The cause of this was still hidden. ...
