was finished, my false shame yielded and I could honestly confess my sins in the Confessional without resistance. Thus, my anguish ended.



The Beauty of His Soul

Joseph is said to have been a young man when he entered into matrimony with Mary, handsome in form, kind in manner, smart in intellect, noble in countenance, honourable in speech, morals, affections, faultless before GOD, most like the Mother of GOD. When I imagine St Joseph with all his merits, he must have been an extraordinarily fine man. What the Psalmist prophesied of CHRIST may also roughly fit him: "You are the most handsome amongst the sons of men; grace is poured upon Your lips; therefore, GOD has blessed You forever." The Mother of GOD could also say with the bride in the Song of Solomon: "My bridegroom is white and ruddy, chosen amongst many thousands." The prophecy of the Patriarch Jacob also meant him when he said: "A blooming youth is Joseph, lovely to look upon …"

St Joseph's virtues shone forth from his eyes and the beauty of his body revealed the beauty of his soul. Joseph's holiness is beyond expression because he was to be married to the most holy Virgin GOD had ever created. Because of his married state, Joseph had to be devoted to
