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excellently versed in the Holy Scriptures. Also St Bartholomew was quite an educated man. Joseph possessed high personal education, but the merit of holiness outweighed all his other excellent abilities.



How Fr Johann Eduard Lamy Experienced St Joseph

As much as we may be touched by the many visions of our LORD and His Mother in the life of this simple, humble Parisian suburban priest, they are not the only apparitions that Father Lamy (1853-1931) received. For his communication with Heaven was so constant that he often enjoyed the visible presence of his heavenly friends and that the supernatural and its world had become, as it were, the greatest naturalness to him. We have already reported before (reference by the author Count Biver) how St Joseph appeared to him one evening in the chapel of "Our Lady of Good Hope" in Troyes and announced that he would become a priest in

spite of all difficulties. Fr Lamy: "At the second apparition in La Courneuve, St Joseph spoke to me only of things concerning myself. He is always very kind, but does not have such a mild voice as the Mother of GOD. The somewhat harsh sound of his oriental homeland is always audible with him. The holy Nursing Father also visited me a third time, again in La Courneuve, but this time not in the church, but in the youth home. It happened in the Sacred Heart room, which was in the old parish garden. The statue of the Holy Patriarch had been brought here from the church to be thoroughly cleaned before being placed on the new more beautiful pedestal bought by a woman from Remiremont.

On 3 July 1917, the statue was carried into the hall, where it remained for several days. As I was constantly very busy, I could not go there as soon as it was cleaned but arrived about three or four days later. The door and window were on the same side, while the rest of the room was in darkness. When I entered the room, the Saint was already standing between his statue and the speaker, smiling kindly. Joyfully I exclaimed: ,Is it You, St Joseph?' Again, he was talking to me about purely personal matters. I remember well that I took a few steps back to be able to observe him even better and that I made a deep bow to him. When I rose again, the apparition had disappeared."

As on his earlier visits, also this time St Joseph already looked quite grey and wore almost the same dress as the divine SAVIOUR. However, St Joseph is not just the simple worker that one would often like to portray him as. That is just a trait of his character. He knew the Psalms very well and was
