

Joseph In the Old and New Testament

She comforted him and asked him to always offer everything up to GOD and to bear it patiently. This would earn him many merits and please the FATHER in Heaven. Joseph always remained friendly towards these rude people or ignored them. He asked GOD to forgive them and prayed for their conversion.

In the little house in Nazareth there was peace, joy, prayer, harmony, and everyone lived completely in the will of GOD. They did their work quietly and silently, their thoughts immersed in GOD. Whenever Joseph came out of his workshop, tired and hot on hot days, the smile of his JESUS and the loving gaze of his Immaculate Mary strengthened him in such a way that he went back to work full of fresh energy.

St Joseph longed for Heaven. He also felt that his strength was dwindling. He always discussed everything with Mary, who always encouraged and comforted him. Joseph thanked JESUS for taking so much work off

The Name of Joseph

GOD wanted to reveal the righteousness of St Joseph by explicitly recording his name in the Gospels. He wanted to make the man who was appointed Protector of Mary known to the people. He wanted to perpetuate the memory of the name of the one who was regarded as the Father of the SON of GOD.



St Gertrude had a vision of how the Angels and Saints venerated the Annunciation. Whenever the name of St Joseph was pronounced, the Saints bowed down deeply in reverence and testified by the serenity and intimacy of their gaze that they rejoiced with him in his sublime dignity

Let us praise the name of Joseph. The glorious name also means growth, abundance. That is to say, how abundant his soul is in heavenly gifts and favours. An uninterrupted stream of grace has poured into his soul ever since Joseph became the head of the Holy Family. After Mary, he is the most perfect masterpiece of GOD.

"Saint Joseph, will You spread Your protective mantle over us all. Please obtain for us that we may all live a living faith, and cherish a firm trust and intimate

love towards GOD. Saint Joseph, obtain for us all great purity of heart, body, and spirit. – Father Joseph, I ask You to help everyone in need and danger, in

temptations and fears, especially at the hour of death. Thank You, my beloved Saint Joseph!"
